Summer Academy 2018:

Members will enjoy the opportunity to participate and explore Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math activities through collaborative team work and hands-on project based learning using the design think model. K-3 grade members will explore science through super heroes and Legos, 4th-5th will learn to code in Scratch, and our 6th-8th grade members will create claymation shorts. At the end of the summer members will have produced collaborative projects with Legos, code and animated shorts to be presented at our STEAM Showcase.

Summer Academy 2018 Attendance Requirements:

- Members must attend 6 out of the 8 weeks of the summer program
- If a member is absent for more than 1 week of the program he/she may be dropped

Members are provided quality instruction & activities, breakfast & lunch daily, field trip experiences and a T-shirt.

Delicious Meals Included

Each day, a nutritious breakfast and lunch are prepared by our outstanding Nutrition Team. *We take great pride in preparing healthy meals. Supper is provided between 4:00 pm-5:00 pm for youth who stay for the afternoon program.

* Free breakfast (8a-9a) and lunch (12p-1p) is available to children under 18 years old throughout the summer via the USDA Summer Food Program.

Space is limited so sign-up early.

(Grade determination based on 2017-2018 school year.)

K-8th graders will be grouped by grade and will participate in curriculum designed to engage collaboratively using the design think model, with emphasis on preventing summer learning loss.

9th-12th graders will participate in the Junior Staff leadership development program. In addition, teens will serve as assistant youth leaders in addition to other community-service learning opportunities. In the afternoon teens will participate in the Junior Staff curriculum.

All participants are eligible to earn Club Dollars by participating in Summer Academy activities. All Summer Academy participants will receive a 2018 Summer T-shirt to be worn on field trips. Bonus Club Dollars may be earned by being selected as a "Student of the Day" for outstanding behavior and participation.

Members can use their Club Dollars to reserve a space on field trips and to shop at Club Store. Field trips cost seven Club Dollars each to attend.

Members must deposit the Club Dollars they earn by the deadlines announced during Daily Briefing in order to reserve their space on field trips or to shop at Club Store. Members must wear their 2018 Summer T-shirts on field trip days.

Field trip opportunities are grade group based and align with the Summer Academy Program.
