Where do campers check-in?

Look for the large adidas flags near the main stadium entrance

Is walk-up registration available during the football camp?

Yes. If space is available, campers can sign up at the late registration table.

Tell me about the coaches

Over 40 volunteer coaches of the Johnson-Toney Football Camp will teach sound fundamentals of the game. All coaches are background checked. Many have extensive sports backgrounds as football coaches and/or campers. Some of our volunteers currently coach in pee wee, high school or college programs. A few current and former NFL players will be on hand to share their knowledge of the game with the campers.

Is this a non-contact football camp?

Yes. This camp is emphasizes proper technique. Campers will be taught proper stance and starts, route running, catching, passing, blocking, covering, basic offensive and defensive formations and more. In addition, campers will play scrimmage games during afternoon sessions.

Should campers bring any special equipment?

Rubber cleats work best to ensure solid footing. Cross training shoes also work well on field turf. All campers are issued a t-shirt and lightweight back pack to store personal belongings. Camper and coaches apparel is donated by adidas.

What should campers wear to the football camp?

Campers are expected to wear their camp-issued adidas t-shirt to camp every day. Please do not alter the t shirt (cutting, marking and tearing of sleeves is not permitted).

Is there anything campers should not bring to camp?

Yes. Please do not bring chewing gum, sunflower seeds, sports drinks or sodas into the stadium. Do not bring valuables to the camp.

Is there a picture day?

Yes. Picture day is Wednesday. Campers will take a full group picture. Everyone will receive a group picture on the last day of camp.

Is a meal provided?

Yes. A free meal is provided all 4 days of camp. Water stations are set up on all fields and near food service areas. Meals are served near the stadium.

Will my child/children practice with other campers in their age range?

Yes. The three age ranges are:

June 24-27, 2019, Monterey Peninsula College, Monterey, CA 9-11 year olds and 12-14 year olds 15-17 year olds

July 30 – August 2 Rabobank Stadium, Salinas, CA

Can parents, friends and family watch practice?

Yes. Spectators are welcome to watch practice from the stands or from a safe distance away on the sidelines.

Where should I park?

Free parking is available at Monterey Peninsula College in Lot C (located on the gymnasium side of the campus). Parking permits are required for all other campus lots.

Free parking is available on the on the scoreboard side at Rabobank Stadium. Enter from Maryal Drive.

Is transportation available for campers?

Yes. Free transportation is available only for the June 24-27, 2019 camp at Monterey Peninsula College. The transportation schedule is listed below.
